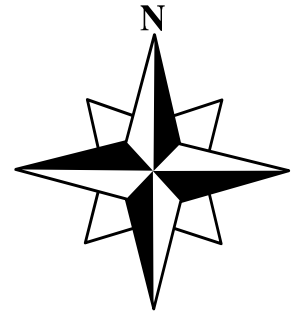

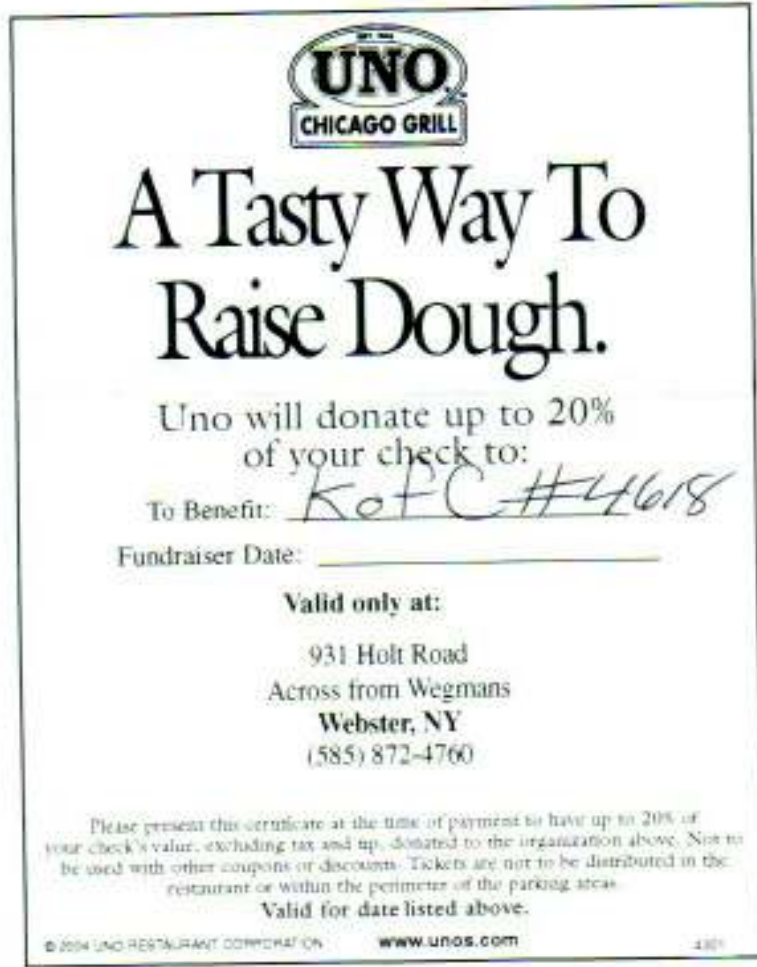
**Infectious Disease Control.**

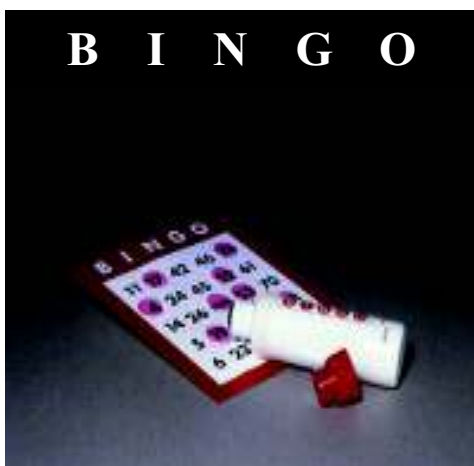
**Name Tags**

Our Brother Knight, Dave Stein, is acting as Web Master for all three.

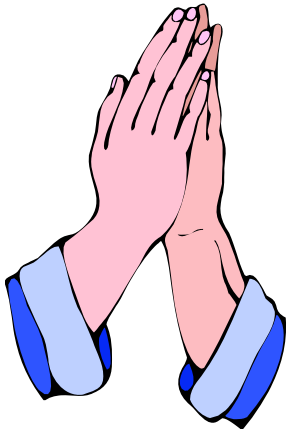

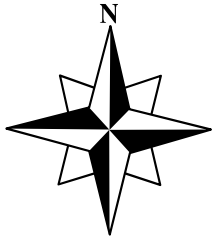
