

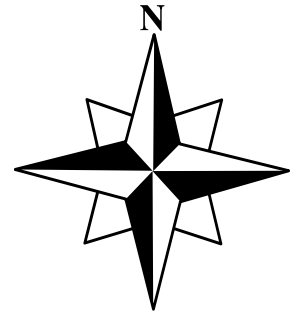

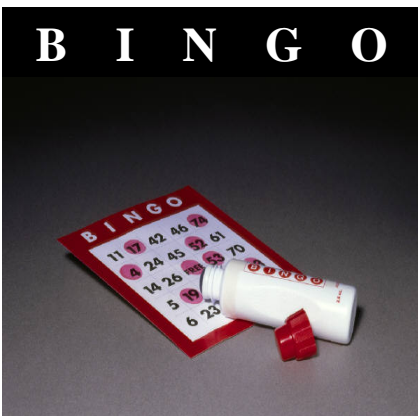

**TRINITY COUNCIL PARTICIPATES
IN THE ULTRASOUND PROGRAM**

In 2008 there were 3766 abortions in Monroe County and 240 abortions in the County of Ontario. This number, to the best of our knowledge, remains about the same at this time. *Focus on the Family*, a national evangelical ministry reported that among women considering abortions in the United States, surveys suggest that 57 per cent will keep their babies after receiving positive counseling at a pregnancy care center (PCC). That number jumps to 79 per cent, an increase of 38 per cent when an expectant mother sees an image of her baby on an ultrasound machine.

About a year ago Trinity Council became aware of a program that makes ultrasound services a possibility for all pregnant women, regardless of their ability to pay or not pay. The Supreme Council of the Knights of Columbus extended an offer to provide a matching grant for local councils, in the United States, who raise half the money for the purchase of an ultrasound machine.

To take advantage of this offer and in support of Trinity Council's Culture of Life (COL) commitment, a collaborative team has evolved with representation from the State of New York K of C Trinity Council, (5 volunteers) Finger Lakes Chapter, The Diocese of Rochester, four pregnancy care centers in the Greater Rochester area, Saint Joseph Neighborhood Center and the ultrasound community.

For most of 2011, this team has developed and implemented a series of actions to sponsor and coordinate the placement of an ultrasound machine in the Saint Joseph Neighborhood Center with a mission to reduce abortions in the Greater Rochester area. This included the following:

1. Identified four (4) Pro-Life Pregnancy centers that help pregnant mothers.
2. Established Saint Joseph's Neighborhood Center, a medically certified, Pro-Life organization, which is willing to provide a "Hub" site for the placement of the ultrasound machine and services.
3. Created a five year income and expense budget for

the program.

4. Developed procedures for the pregnant care centers and the "Hub" center.

5. Selected and made plans to purchase the ultrasound machine

6. Coordinated multiple fundraising activities with the K of C organizations in the state of New York, parishes within The Diocese of Rochester and individuals who support this program.

7. Completed and submitted the formal application to the Supreme Council.

While much has been accomplished, much remains to be done. Currently our application to the Supreme Council is being reviewed. Our fundraising activities are on schedule, but we still have a ways to go to insure that we have the necessary funding to provide for all expected expenses for the next five years. Finally, we are developing the policies and procedures to insure that we have a crystal – clear process for the interactions between the pregnancy care centers and the "Hub" location.

We are fortunate to have so many individuals and organizations, working on this project who have willingly given of their time, talent, treasure and support to this Pro-Life initiative. We are confident that this effort will result in reducing the number of abortions and help save lives in the Greater Rochester Area.

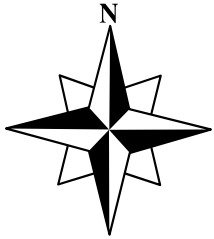
